## Payment & Refund Policy:

- Tuition refunds are guaranteed up to 3 weeks prior to the start date of a program minus a \$10 administrative fee. Cancellations within the three weeks prior to the program are nonrefundable if the child's spot cannot be filled. If the spot can be filled, a full refund minus the \$10 administrative fee will be given.
- There will be no tuition refunds for cancellations made after a program has begun.
- No full or partial tuition refund or credit will be given for a child's failure to attend any part of a program for which they are registered
- We will do our best to adapt our programs to the weather and reschedule any
  weather-related program cancellations. In the event that we must cancel a
  program and we are unable to reschedule, that day's portion of program tuition
  will be refunded.

## **Student Safety Policy:**

- The safety and well-being of your child is our utmost concern. Outdoor education on a working farm involves learning and playing in a dynamic environment. For their safety, children are prohibited from touching farm equipment and implements. We will monitor weather closely and cancel in advance if there is risk of thunderstorms, heavy rain, or if temperatures become too high or low for student safety. If your child has trouble staying with the group or following teacher directions as they relate to safety, staff may ask that the child attend the program with a caregiver's assistance.
- Children in preschool and school age programs will not be required to wear
  masks at this time. However, all children, educators, farmers and visitors to the
  farm will be required to mask up when entering and using the bathrooms. Of
  course parents or caregivers may require their individual children to wear masks,
  and educators will fully support this decision.
- Educators will ensure regular hand washing, physical spacing during any prolonged rest period (ex. snack or story-telling), and will clean surfaces before and after food prep.
- Please check your child for COVID-related symptoms each day using our <u>Daily Symptoms Checker</u> (emailed to all families prior to program start). Plan to keep your child home if they are experiencing any of these symptoms or if at any point they are identified as a close contact.
- The data about COVID continues to change, and we will continue to evaluate and adapt our safety policies accordingly.
